This year's celebration is September 6-10, 2010. NPW celebrates the hard work by America's 156 million wage earners and the payroll professionals who pay them. Together, through the payroll withholding system, they contribute, collect, report and deposit approximately \$1.8 trillion, or 65.7%, of the annual revenue of the U.S. Treasury.

Save Abandoned Dogs



It is estimated 2,500 kittens and puppies are born every hour in the United States, far more than can ever find good homes. Unwanted animals are dumped at the local pound or abandoned in woods and on city streets, where they suffer from starvation, lack of shelter and veterinary care, and abuse by cruel people. Animal shelters can adopt out only a fraction of the animals they receive, and the rest—about 8 to 10 million—must be put to death.

Animal Aid Society is a “no-kill” dog shelter. The shelter is completely staffed by volunteers and they receive no state or federal funding. Support the Virginia Statewide Payroll Conference’ efforts in helping to save abandoned and abused dogs. Judging Criteria:

Awards: List awards and other forms of recognition the nominee has received.

Professional Service: Cite offices, committee assignments and other examples of the nominee's service to their local payroll organizations.
